## VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

<b>Pooch Paparazzi</b>	
<b>POSITION DESCRIPTION</b>	<p>Pooch Paparazzi volunteers have an eye for photography and an ability to capture the cutest shots of our adoptable GSDs for our website, publications and Petfinder. The Center is looking for several “Pooch Paparazzis” throughout the New England area.</p> <p>These volunteers work with the Foster Counselor and Foster Homes to take high quality pictures of our GSDs available for adoption. They also may take pictures of a dog at intake at their source shelter.</p> <p>They also edit pictures when needed and upload/send the pictures to our communications team.</p> <p>When a photo session requirement comes up, we will contact you to check your availability to attend. You can say yes or no depending on whether or not you can accommodate the request on any given day and the location of the event.</p> <p>We will give you as much notice as possible, but at we will provide at least one week’s notice at a minimum.</p> <p>Videographers are also needed!</p>
<b>WHAT YOU NEED TO DO THIS JOB</b>	<p>Telephone, email, computer, internet connection.</p> <p>Volunteers must have their own insured vehicle and a valid driver's license.</p> <p>Willingness to travel back and forth to photo sessions in your personal vehicle.</p> <p>Photography experience a plus but not required.</p> <p>Patience.</p> <p>A sense of humor.</p> <p>Did we say patience?</p>
<b>SHIFTS</b>	Varies but we estimate two monthly 3 hours shifts.
<b>LOCATION</b>	Varies but we try to keep our assignment requests close to where you live.

COMMITMENT	We would prefer a 1 year commitment but will take what you can give!
TRAINING REQUIREMENTS:	Attend a Volunteer Orientation that explains the overall objectives of the Center as an organization. This can be done in person or by telephone. Complete the Volunteer Safe Animal Handling Seminar. Attend two photo sessions with an experienced Pooch Paparazzi Volunteer before working independently.

Completing and submitting this application does not indicate acceptance and placement. Acceptance into and continued participation in the volunteer program is, among other things, dependent the volunteer's approach and comfort level of working with animals, rescue groups, animal shelters and GSRRC's specific activities, and whether GSRRC has positions available for the volunteer's specified time slots.*
