POSITION DESCRIPTION

We are looking for volunteers throughout New England to join our Transport Team. The Transport Team Volunteers transports just about anything:

- Foster Kits to Foster Homes expecting a rescue GSD
- A rescue GSD from a shelter to a Foster Home
- A rescue GSD to a Vet appointment
- Supplies from point of purchase to inventory location

When a transport comes up, we will contact you to check your availability. You can say yes or no depending on whether or not you can accommodate the request on any given day and the source and destination of the transport.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO THIS JOB	A telephone. A computer and internet connections is a plus. Volunteers must have their own insured vehicle and a valid driver's license. Willingness to transport GSDs/items in your personal vehicle. A sense of humor.
SHIFTS	Could range from as little as 1 hour to as many as 4 hours, depending on the pickup and drop off locations of the items or GSDs being transported.
LOCATION	Varies but we try to match up the transports to or from the region where the volunteer lives and keep it to a reasonable distance.
COMMITMENT	We would appreciate any commitment you can give!
TRAINING REQUIREMENTS	Attend a Volunteer Orientation that explains the overall objectives of the Center as an organization. This can be done in person or by telephone. Complete the Volunteer Safe Animal Handling Seminar. Shadow/work with an experienced volunteer on at least two transports.

Note: All Volunteers must complete a volunteer application, sign a release and liability waiver and receive approval from the GSRRC BOD. Completing and submitting this application does not indicate acceptance and placement. Acceptance into and continued participation in the volunteer program is, among other things, dependent the volunteer's approach and comfort level of working with animals, rescue groups, animal shelters and GSRRC's specific activities, and whether GSRRC has positions available for the volunteer's specified time slots.
